Barber Scholarship Application Process Deadlines And Application Information

This program began through the generosity of the late Edwin J. Barber, who provided funds for this program in his estate plan. This scholarship fund is designed to assist students seeking training for full-time service in the church. This may include M.A.R. and M.Div. programs at accredited theological schools; however, scholarships have also been awarded to students completing their undergraduate degree prior to enrolling in a master's program.

The scholarship application deadline is June 30, 2025 for the 2025-2026 school year. Scholarships will be awarded by July 30, 2025. A minimum of \$500 has been established for each scholarship awarded. Our evaluation process is limited to study of the written material you submit with your application form. Because personal interviews are not part of our evaluation process, the written material you submit is the primary factor we use in comparing your application to the applications of others. The content of your narrative statement will greatly impact our selection process. I encourage you to give your written material your strongest preparation and editing efforts.

Our areas of focus are determined by the guidelines of the trust. Geography was a concern for Mr. Barber. Applicants who have lived locally are given priority over applicants who have not spent any time residing in our area. This geographical component is factored into our evaluation of your application. We also will look at your progress toward degree completion. While this scholarship is not restricted to "honor level" students, we will consider your academic performance. Our committee desires to gain good insight into your commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. The weight of emphasis given to each of these factors is listed on the application form. - Your level of progress toward completion of educational requirements for your degree. A description of the course grades you have received will help us see how you are evaluated in an academic setting. (10%) Please include a copy of your official transcript.
- Each applicant is given the opportunity to show how he or she merits assistance with the cost of education. (15%)
